



Scholarship: Copernicus Center Scholarship for Postdoctoral Researchers

Programme Description:

The Copernicus Center Scholarship for Postdoctoral Researchers, funded by The John Templeton Foundation, is offered to individuals who hold a PhD degree (or equivalent) in the fields of: physics, cosmology, astronomy, mathematics, philosophy of science, history of science and related disciplines. Preferred research areas:

- (1) Generalized geometries and their application in physics;
- (2) Observational and conceptual consequences of a class of alternative theories of gravitation;
- (3) Symbolic computation in cosmology;
- (4) Scientific method at its limit. Philosophical consequences of recent theories and models.

The Copernicus Center offers one scholarship in the aforementioned fields. The scholarship in the amount of \$2000 gross will be awarded for 12 months (starting date March 2012).

- (3) Outline of the post-doctoral project.
- (4) Very good or excellent language skills (English).
- (5) Academic publications and talks at academic conferences .
- (6) Participation in research grants.

Obligations:

- (1) Monthly reports on progress of the postdoctoral project.
- (2) Preparation of 2 research papers and 2 talks during the scholarship.

The applications should include:

- (2) List of publications
- (3) A scanned copy of the PhD diploma(s)
- (4) Language certificate (if applicable)
- (5) Research project (outline)
